

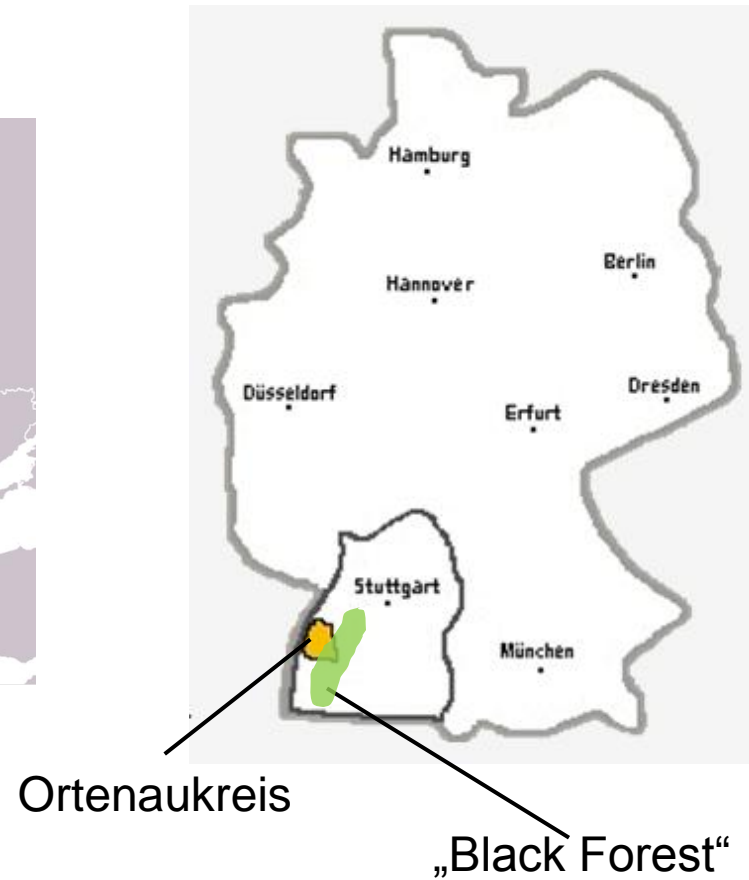

- Lack of involvement of the region



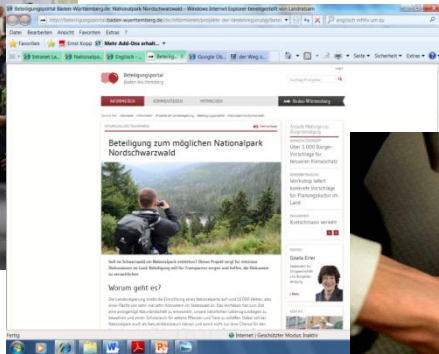

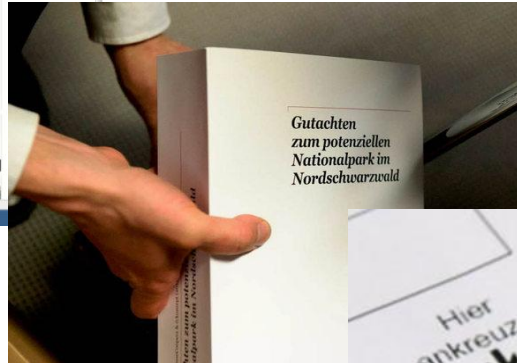
